

Tough Mudder 2017

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Submitting the application form does not guarantee you a place in the Tough Mudder, places are subject to availability.
2. You must be at least 18 years old on event day in order to take part.
3. To secure a guaranteed place you must pay a £50 non-refundable registration fee.
4. By signing the pledge on the application form and securing your place with the registration fee, you pledge to raise a minimum of £300 and understand that it is the aim of this event to raise as much above this amount as possible in aid of Meningitis Now.
5. Monies claimed from HMRC for Gift Aid do not count towards your fundraising total.
6. By registering for the challenge you agree to raise the minimum sponsorship of £300. Of this amount, 80% (£240) must be paid to Meningitis Now at least eight weeks prior to the event date. The remaining 20% (£60) must be covered by proof of pledges and must be paid to Meningitis Now within four weeks of completing the event.
7. If at any point you feel that you are unable to raise the pledged amount you should inform Meningitis Now immediately in order that we have the opportunity to offer assistance with your fundraising.
8. All funds raised in the name of Meningitis Now must be paid to Meningitis Now.
9. All additional costs related to this event including, but not limited to, travel and accommodation are the participant's responsibility.
10. The place remains the property of Meningitis Now. Meningitis Now reserves the right to withdraw the place at any time.
11. Should you have to withdraw from the event you must inform Meningitis Now immediately. When your withdrawal is acknowledged you will not be liable to raise any further sponsorship. Funds already paid to Meningitis Now are refundable (registration fee is non-refundable). Any monies must be returned to the donors or donated to Meningitis Now with their permission.
12. You participate in the Tough Mudder at your own risk. It is your responsibility to train adequately for the event and to consult your doctor if you have any concerns about your ability to complete the event safely.
13. You agree that Meningitis Now can use any photographs taken at the event in any literature, publicity, information material or publication promoting the work of Meningitis Now. This may include brochures, posters, leaflets, display boards, Meningitis Now website and any other such appropriate materials.
