By donating your dormant funds you will be joining the fight against meningitis and helping people across the UK to receive free, specialist aftercare.

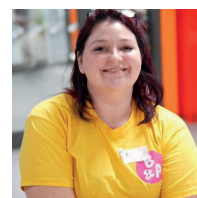
